Dear Prospective Student:

It is our pleasure to welcome you as a prospective student to the Collinson Massage School. Our school is in its 27th year. We have many graduates that are successful massage therapists throughout the world. Our mission is to help you reach your goal in Massage Therapy.

Our new 600 hour course will begin on Nov 10, 2009, and will meet each Tuesday evening from 6:15 p.m. until 10:15 p.m. for 24 weeks. We still offer our 1000 hour course, of which you are invited to continue into should you be interested in more in-depth study. The additional hours will introduce you to things that you may be interested in incorporating into your massage business like Hot Stone therapy, Aromatherapy, Healing Touch, Reiki, Reflexology, etc... The massage course is designed with the working and/or busy person in mind. There is a minimum amount of structured time spent in the classroom while most of the hours are spent in self study. Most of the classroom hours are used for the hands-on teaching of massage techniques and other types of bodywork. The hours outside of class are for studying Anatomy and Physiology, practicing your massage techniques, as well as participating in a mentorship learning experience.

If you would like to become a member of the upcoming class, please send in your completed application along with the application fee of \$50.00. Tuition rates are as follows: 1000hr program--- \$5500, 600 hr program --\$3600. Tuition includes all textbooks, manuals, worksheets, and classroom supplies (i.e. linens, massage lotion, etc.) Tuition for both classes can be paid in monthly payments of \$545.00 for 10 months for the 1000 hr program and \$600 for 6 months for the 600 hr program, with the first payment due on the first day of class. There is no interest charged with these payment plans *if full payment is made by the end of the course*. If we receive the *full* course payment within the first 30 days of class we can offer the 1000 hr course to you for only \$5250, a savings of \$250, and the 600 hr course for \$3500, a savings of \$100.

Pikes Peak Community Action Agency has a program in place to help low-income individuals by matching contributions in an account with ENT Federal Credit Union which can pay for the majority of your tuition. To find out more information on this program contact Gregg Jones at 719 385-7910.

There are a limited number of students accepted in each class due to space and ability to give each student the proper amount of attention. Therefore, students will be accepted on a first-come basis.

The Collinson Massage School is committed to giving students a complete education in massage therapy, teaching many types of body work and introducing business practice, so you can be successful in this growing field. It is our philosophy that massage is a viable alternative healthcare to people with musculoskeletal pain and nerve disorders and chronic systemic issues. We also teach the philosophy and physiology of how massage therapy facilitates the body's own healing process and how to work and interact with all health care professionals. Our students learn how to keep S.O.A.P. notes, file insurance claims, and how to start and run a business.

Your teachers will be Sally Mellon and Ellen Sommer, licensed massage therapists, who have been in their own successful massage practices since 1983. They have been teaching at the Collinson School for 23 years. We also have regular guest speakers that are experts in their field of study.
